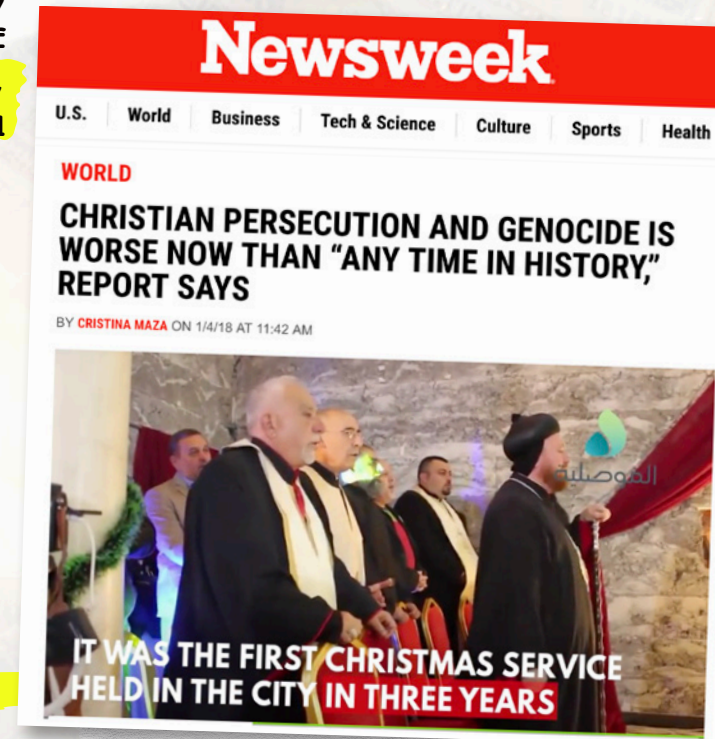

Topline View from Newsweek and Aid to Church in Need (CAN) Report

- A. Here are 13 countries where Christians face the worst abuse, ACN has reported that the outlook has gotten worse in each of these 13 countries: China, Egypt, Eritrea, India, Iran, Iraq, Nigeria, North Korea, Pakistan, Saudi Arabia, Sudan, Syria and Turkey.
- B. The ACN report states that in countries like Iraq and Syria, Christians would have been entirely wiped out if it weren't for military action and the assistance of Christian humanitarian organizations. Almost 1 million Christians have been martyred in Iraq.
- C. Other than military encounters in Iraq and Syria, governments in the West and the U.N. are failing to offer Christians the emergency help that is necessary.
- D. In Sudan, the government ordered that churches be destroyed.
- E. In Nigeria, ISIS-affiliated groups like Boko Haram have led a surge in attacks on Christians.

F. In Eritrea, hundreds of Christians have been rounded up and imprisoned over the past year because of their faith.

G. Christians in countries such as India and Nigeria were murdered or beaten for practicing their faith.

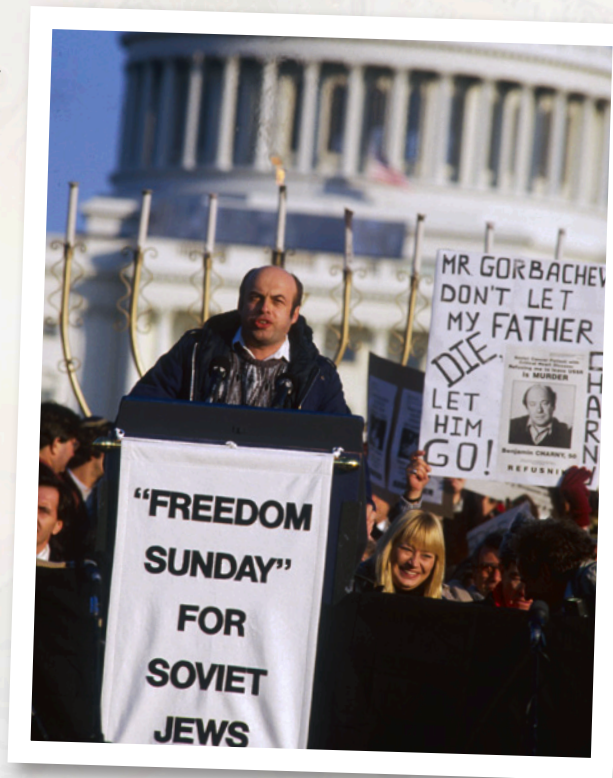
Economic focus can change the rules of engagement:

U.S. Treaties have been used to leverage non-market economies to MFN (Most Favored Nation) status based on whether or not they support basic human rights.

Case Study 1: Economic pressure was used to save the Jewish people and take down the Soviet Union. Trade Act in 1974 tied non-market economies' access to Most-Favored Nation (MFN) status to their allowing freedom of emigration.

The Soviets refused to agree and thus were denied the ability to tap into U.S. investment, financing, credits, technology transfers and other forms of what would have amounted to economic life-support for their failing system.

THE RESULT: When President Reagan adopted a strategy in 1983 for destroying the Soviet Union that entailed, among other things, waging economic warfare against the Kremlin, the absence of such an MFN-enabled safety net contributed greatly to the demise of the USSR.

CASE STUDY 2: Turkey arrests Andrew Brunson, a Christian who was charged with terrorism based on his Christian beliefs. They believed he helped inspire a failed military coup in 2016.

Brunson claimed,

"I an innocent man, I love Jesus, I love Turkey."**

Despite failed efforts to release Brunson previously, President Trump ultimately implemented sanctions and tariffs that drove down their currency.

THE RESULT: Just several months after economic pressure was applied, Brunson was released and sent back to the U.S. in 2018. During court proceedings, the prosecution backtracked their previous testimony regarding Brunson's alleged crimes.
