### ***The Polar Express (2004)***

While centered on belief and wonder, the film also reflects economic transition. By juxtaposing technological progress with tradition, it illustrates that innovation alone does not guarantee prosperity—systems must preserve trust, meaning, and purpose to remain healthy.

### ***Rudolph the Red-Nosed Reindeer (1964)***

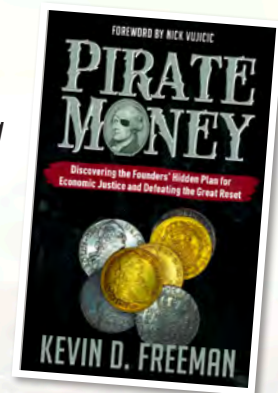

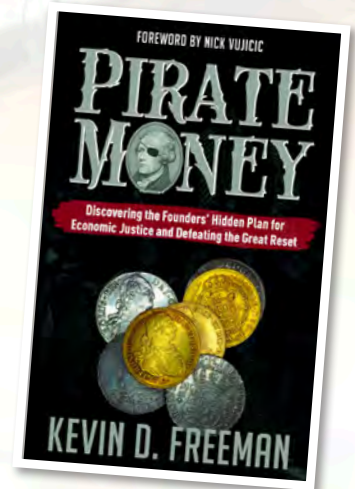
